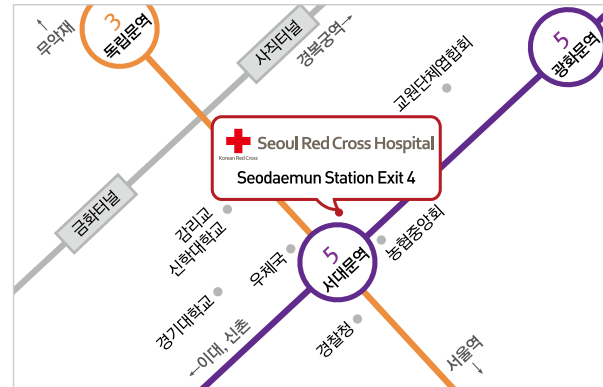
Target

Healthy Neighbor Center

Healthy Neighbor Center found in collaboration with the Hyundai Motor Chung Mong-Koo Foundation and Seoul National University Hospital, and it is located in the located in Seoul Red Cross Hospital where it provides personalized health care services to foreign workers, refugees, multicultural families and other minority groups who are at a disadvantage in medical services.



Major Programs



Medical Cost Support

Program designed to offer medical cost support to medically vulnerable foreigners including foreign workers, refugees and multicultural families



Public Medicine Education

Health education for fields staffs engaging in health lecturing/free clinics offering services to immigrants (multicultural families, foreign workers, refugees, etc.) in Korea

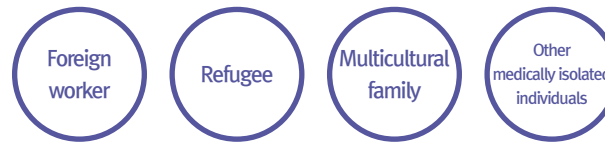


Public Medicine Network Establishment

Network establishment and partnership agreements with public and NGO organizations related to foreigners, and collaboration programs, joint research and academic exchanges (i.e. symposiums, explanation sessions with related organizations) with clinics for foreigners and other hospitals

Medical Cost Support

Target



- Foreigners who are under economic difficulty in need of urgent medical cost support
- Foreigner who has been in Korea for at least 90 days since the last date of entry
→ **Must present passport and verification of entry**
- Foreigners who did not come to Korea for medical treatment
→ Service unavailable in case of medical tourism and domiciliary care

Support Range

“50-100% of medical cost incurred to the patient (outpatient, hospitalization)”

- Support rate determined according to medical cost support assessment table
- Exclusion: Dental, pharmaceutical, medical statement issuing, meals for caregiver, simple inspections requested by patient

Medical Cost Support Procedure



Requires application from patient after 1st diagnosis from medical facility



Phone inquiry (send application when inquiring other facility)

→ Attach Healthy Neighbor Center Patient Application form (www.hncenter.or.kr)



Consultation Reserve

Visit Healthy Neighbor Center

: Consultation and submit related documents

- Patient Application (if patient is recommended by other facility)
- Treatment Request or Doctor's Statement
- Passport (mandatory) or Registration Card
- Rental Agreement/Verification of Free Housing
- Bank statement (6 months)
- Confirmation of Employment and Salary Statement (additional documents may be requested after consultation)



Social/economic situation assessed by interview with social worker



Support rate determined through internal discussion

→ 50-100% of medical cost (support rate determined according to medical cost support assessment table)
